



## Freee space in a dream location

A good event location not only convinces with suitable rooms and technical equipment, but also with that certain something. The Inselhalle Lindau offers exactly this wow factor, which will inspire you and your quests: On one side, it borders the historic old town of the Lindau island, which spreads a very special flair with its romantic, winding alleys at all times of the year. On the other side, the lake awaits - and with it the offer to let your gaze wander, your thoughts flow and your horizon expand. No wonder, then, that pioneers and thinkers, graduates and ambitious people, scientists and artists have been coming together here for decades. Whether for cultural events or renowned conferences, small workshops or international congresses. The Inselhalle offers space for up to 2,000 people - and plenty of room for encounters, insights and visions.

#### One hall - 46 options for space

The large auditorium continues to be the main feature of the new Inselhalle. The space has been renovated according to plans by the renowned architectural practice Auer Weber and it now appears more elegant than ever before. Superb acoustics and capacity for more than 1,100 guests make it ideal for plenary sessions during conferences or for concerts. It can be divided into three smaller halls. Ten new conference rooms on the ground floor and two at the basement level are grouped around that central space. The Clou: due to its modular design, the new Inselhalle Lindau offers 46 room



options for events of all kinds and sizes, from galas and workshops, to seminars and get-togethers in our light-filled Main Foyer, for example, which at 1,000 m², has been extended to more than three times its previous size.

#### Tradition meets modernity-and nature

Visually, too, the Inselhalle, designed by Munich architects Auer Weber, is a highlight of modern architecture that blends in perfectly with the island: for example, the striking polygonal roof in its copper colour picks up the look of the roofs of Lindau's old town; generous glass surfaces provide a view of the lake and greenery. The adjacent 2,500 square metre Therese-von-Bayern-

Platz is used as an additional activity area for many events. The consistent architecture is continued in the Inselhalle P4 multi-storey car park, which offers 400 parking spaces in the direct vicinity of the event location.






## **Main Foyer**





The spacious, light-filled main foyer is the central reception and entrance area. Access is via Therese-von-Bayern square. From the foyer, you have easy access to all function rooms, including the conference rooms. The foyer may also be used for cate-

ring and serves as an informal meeting place during breaks. It is also ideal for exhibitions. The central conference office next to the entrance can be used as an information desk or ticket office. If required, conference rooms 1-3 can be added to extend the space.



## Large auditorium






## **Lakeside Foyer**





In the northern part of the Inselhalle is the lakeside foyer, which is accessible through the halls as well as the main foyer and the restaurant. The continuous glass front provides plenty of light and a great view - in good weather the doors to the terrace

can be opened along their entire length. The direct proximity to the Small Lake offers a stylish ambience for receptions, breaks or aperitifs – and in the evening a dreamlike view of the sun setting over the water.



## Conference rooms 1-3





The three conference rooms on the east side of the building have been designed to face the Therese-von-Bayern square and the lakeside. They are flexible and can be combined into different rooms, offering

space for up to 312 delegates. As you would expect, the rooms have been fitted with the most modern equipment in conference technology, ideal for talks and workshops.



A further seven conference rooms of assorted sizes are available on the south-side of the complex. Four of those can be combined through flexible moveable walls, which can be tailored to your needs. Due to the most modern conference technology, premium floor cover and the availability of

full blackout equipment, these spaces offer the perfect setting for meetings and workshops. Additionally, rooms 9 and 10 offer acoustic separation, making them ideal for confidential meetings.



## Lounge area - basement level





The large staircase in the main foyer leads to the basement, where there is a central lounge area and two further conference rooms with natural light. A landscaped

atrium and generous steps leading to the Kleine See lakeside promenade offer plenty of space for active breaks outdoors.

The ONU restaurant is directly connected to the conference and event area via the Inselhalle's lakeside foyer. It is also accessible to the public via a separate entrance.

It offers approx. 120 seats indoors and around 130 seats outdoors and can be booked both exclusively and as part of events in the Inselhalle.



Since its reopening in 2018, the Inselhalle Lindau has enjoyed a high level of popularity among its event customers and their participants. In 2019, around 96,000 participants were welcomed to the Inselhalle for 181 events on 323 occupied days. The economic basis of the Inselhalle's event operations are conferences and congresses; in terms of volume, workshops & and seminars lead the statistics. Lectures and presentations, trade fairs and exhibitions, concerts and celebrations of various kinds round off the portfolio of the Inselhalle Lindau.



#### Lindau Psychoterapy Weeks

The Lindau Psychotherapy Weeks are by far the congress with the largest number of participants. They are one of the world's largest events in the field of psychotherapy and gather over 4,000 medical and psychological psychotherapists and members of related professions in Lindau every year during two weeks of events. The event has been held annually in the Inselhalle since 1950; lectures, talks and seminars are offered.



### **Lindau Nobel Laureate Conference**

Probably the best-known flagship with international appeal is the annual Nobel Laureate Meetings:Since 1951, more than 30 Nobel Laureates and over 600 young scientists from all over the world have met annually in Lindau. Every year, the conference is devoted to medicine, physics and chemistry. The aim is the intercultural and intergenerational exchange of knowledge and experience. Lectures, discussion rounds, panel discussions and master classes form the bulk of the programme.



#### **Religions for Peace**

In August 2019, the world assembly of "Religions for Peace" took place for the first time in the Inselhalle. During the high-profile meeting, around 1,000 representatives of the largest religious and cultural communities, governments, NGOs and multilateral institutions from all over the world met in the Inselhalle Lindau. They exchanged views on how dialogue between religions can promote peace.
